A Thanksgiving lunch will be held in the Fellowship Hall on November 4 at 11:00am. All ladies of the Church are invited.

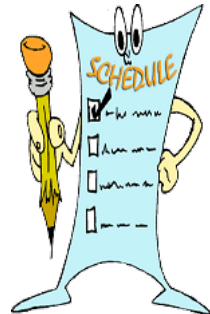
Turkey and Ham will be provided. Those attending are asked to bring a covered dish or dessert to share.
